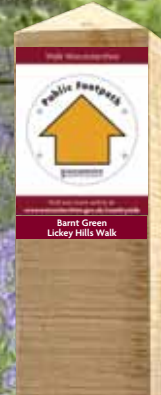




Walk Worcestershire is a series of easy to use and well waymarked walks.



Fact File

Start	The Victoria Public House Hewell Road, Barnt Green, B45 8NW
Length	4 miles
Parking	Barnt Green or Lickey Hills Visitor Centre
Gates/Stiles	9 gates, 0 stiles
Terrain	A substantial climb onto the Lickey Hills and some roadside walking.

The Countryside Code

- Be safe – plan ahead and follow any signs
- Leave gates and property as you find them
- Protect plants and animals. Take your litter home
- Keep dogs under close control & clean up after them
- Consider other people



Barnt Green Lickey Hills Walk

The Barnt Green Lickey Hills walk takes you through the beautiful countryside surrounding this rural village. The landscape varies from open countryside views, mature woodland to larger expanses of water at the Upper and Lower Bittell Reservoirs.

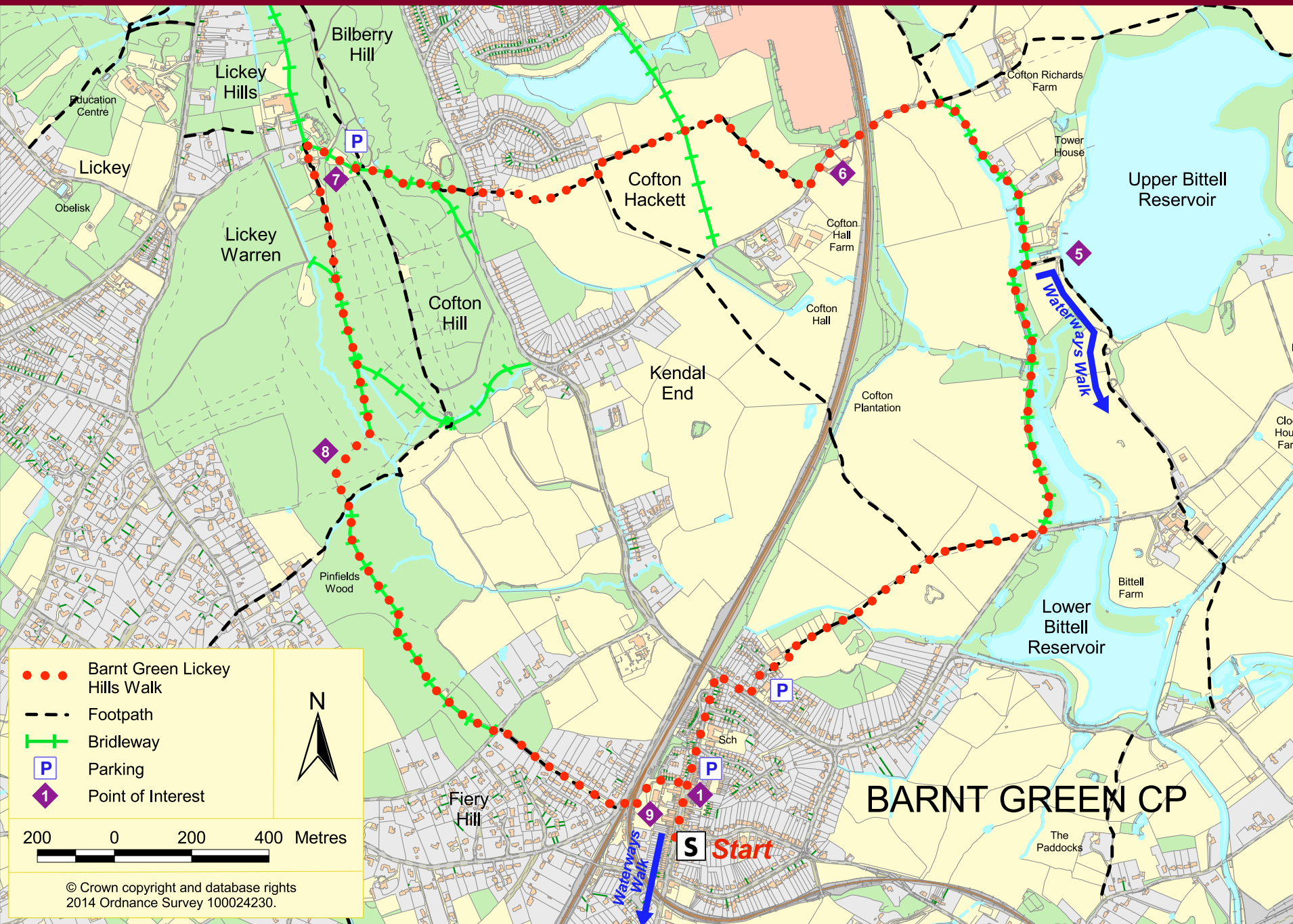


Barnt Green

Despite the closeness of Birmingham, Barnt Green has a rural feel being surrounded by large areas of green-belt, the preserved landscape of the Lickey Hills Country Park, the Birmingham to Worcester canal and the Upper and Lower Bittell Reservoirs.

Barnt Green is an ideal place to start and finish a walk. The village contains destination shops, a well-equipped play area for young children and two tea shops. Food and drink are available at the highly regarded Victoria public house which is centrally located in the village.
