
Despite the closeness of Birmingham, Barnt Green has a rural feel being surrounded by large areas of green-belt, the preserved landscape of the Lickey Hills Country Park, the Birmingham to Worcester canal and the Upper and Lower Bittell Reservoirs.

Barnt Green is an ideal place to start and finish a walk. The village contains destination shops, a well-equipped play area for young children and two tea shops. Food and drink are available at the highly regarded Victoria public house which is centrally located in the village.
